



PLAYER RESPONSIBILITIES



All players are responsible for knowing and understanding these guidelines

- 1. CHECK IN** - Check in with the Tournament Desk at least 30 minutes before each match.
- 2. CODE OF CONDUCT** - While on and off court, all players must adhere to the US SQUASH Code of Conduct.
- 3. AFTER YOUR MATCH** - Upon completing the match, the losing player will take the iPod device from the referees, remain at the court, and time the five-minute warm up. The winning player must go to the tournament desk to turn in the score sheet and obtain the score sheet for the next match on their court.
- 4. REFEREEING AND MARKING** – *Winners* are to act as the Referee of the next match and *losers* are to act as the Marker of the next match.
 - REFEREE** – Calls all Strokes, Lets and No Lets during the matches. The Referee will also use the iPod device to score the match.
 - MARKER** - Keeps track of the score by writing down and announcing each point. The Marker also calls any serves, tins or double bounces out, down, or not up respectively.
- 5. MID-TOURNAMENT DEFAULT** – For any withdrawal after the beginning of a tournament, the player must be present to referee the match they will default in order to retain points for their tournament. If a player abandons a tournament or is unable to attend to referee their final match, they will receive zero points for their participation in the tournament.
- 6. REFEREEING REQUIREMENTS** – A player not fulfilling their refereeing responsibilities may lose his or her current US Squash referee certification and will need to retake the online age-specific referee exam.
- 7. CHECK DRAWS** – Be sure to check the draws to find out when your next match will be. If you have any questions about where you move or feed into another draw be sure to check with the Tournament Desk.
