HOW TO APPLY: Apply the spray to a microfiber cloth and wipe down the equipment. Use PureGreen 24 on the equipment for at least 2 minutes for general disinfection purposes and at least 10 minutes for fungus and viral control.



2XL GymWipes24™

HOW TO APPLY: Use Gym Wipes on the equipment for at least 2 minutes for general disinfection purposes.



Mild Soap and Water

Mild soap and water or a mild non-abrasive household cleaner can also be used to clean the display and all exterior surfaces of Life Fitness equipment.

HOW TO APPLY: Use a soft microfiber cloth only. Apply soap and water to the microfiber cloth before cleaning.

TESTING RESULTS OF OTHER CLEANERS (limited lab testing only)

- Until we can do further testing, our recommendation is to **avoid** cleaners that contain **hydrogen peroxide, sodium hydroxide** or are **"oxy"-based** cleaners. Ensure that any cleaners are properly diluted – do not use cleaner concentrates directly on equipment.
- Avoid using cleaners that contain an abrasive or are strongly acidic or basic.
- Electrostatic dispensers or foggers have never been tested by Life Fitness. However, this application method is unlikely to present a risk to our equipment if the chemical is applied thinly and care is taken to avoid spraying directly on consoles or directly on other powered electrical components. Avoid excessive application that allows liquid disinfectants to puddle on the equipment surface.

GENERAL COMPOSITION OF TESTED CLEANERS

- GymWipes contains mostly ammonium chloride compounds
- PureGreen24 contains Citric Acid
- Other tested cleaners mostly contain weak acids and surfactants, no cleaners with basic chemicals (ph > 7) were tested
- Poor performers contain hydrogen peroxide (among other things)

If a cleaner is not listed, it has not been tested by Life Fitness
